

CARBON NEUTRALITY POLICY STATEMENT

Bespoke Construction Group Ltd is committed to reducing its carbon emissions to neutrality and implementing appropriate measures as an element of its overall carbon emissions reduction strategy, helping it to achieve neutrality in potentially harmful carbon emissions to land, water, and air. It is committed to reducing its carbon emissions in all aspects of its commercial decisions and operations and to achieving carbon neutrality by 2030.

Its carbon reduction strategy is closely aligned with its UKAS certificated ISO 14001:2015 Environmental Policy Statement and associated business management systems and all relevant current environmental legislation.

As its “green culture” becomes established and embedded it will seek to:

- Encourage its workers and suppliers to act responsibly.
- Reduce its use of energy in its operations and at its offices.
- Seek to use only green energy wherever practicable or possible.
- Endeavour to work with partnering organisations, such as suppliers, that share its ethos on “carbon footprint” in order to reduce carbon emissions impacts in its purchasing.
- Reduce the use of carbon emitting transport and its impacts, by way of vehicle sharing and travel mileage reduction in its operational planning.
- Procure fuel-efficient, low emissions or electric vehicles.
- Evaluate energy efficiency and water consumption throughout its operations.
- Ensure that, where possible, materials are recycled/re-used or are segregated into specific waste bins to reduce the use of waste carriers and in accordance with the Waste Hierarchy.
- Use local suppliers and labour, where possible.
- Deliver “carbon awareness training” to all its workers.

To achieve this, Bespoke Construction Group Ltd will:

- Set up a Carbon Reduction Team (CRT) which will meet regularly to monitor progress
- Work with its suppliers, customers, and other interested parties across the country to assist them with their own carbon emissions reduction programmes
- Develop and implement a Carbon Reduction Plan (CRP)
- Thereafter, monitor its progress and carbon reductions and publicly report accordingly
